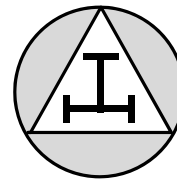


San Diego York Rite Newsletter

Companions and Sir Knights,

This edition of the San Diego York Rite Newsletter marks the beginning of a new year for all four of the San Diego York Rite Bodies. All of them had a pretty good year in 2011 (although I have no idea where the year went) and hopefully 2012 will be even better.

The Commandery installed their 2012 officers on Tuesday evening, 13 December and it was an outstanding evening with all three of the presiding California York Rite Grand officers present. San Diego Chapter and San Diego Council will install their 2012 officers on Thursday evening, 26 January with dinner at 6:00 PM, the Chapter installation beginning at 7:00 PM with the Council installation beginning at 8:00 PM. Please try to be with us for this most important evening in the York Rite Year.

In 2012 we will continue our county-wide cooperation in the conferral of the Chapter and Council degrees, working with Tyre Chapter 130, Triangle Chapter 155 and Helix Council 58 to make the best use of our ritualistic and real estate resources. And the Commandery will continue to work with Riverside and San Bernardino Commanderies in the conferral of the Templar Orders. As the new year dawns please help all the officers of all the bodies in welcoming those who were exalted, greeted and knights in 2011. We need all the depth and breadth we can find in performing the several functions of the bodies and expanding, as we are able, the things we do.

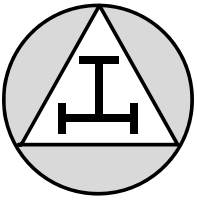
Traditionally we hold our Royal Arch Festivals on the first Saturday in March and on the third Saturday in September. The Cryptic Festivals are held on the third Thursday in March and on the Wednesday following the third Saturday in September. We work the Templar Orders in cooperation with the Commanderies in Riverside and San Bernardino. Usually the spring festival is held in San Bernardino and the fall festival is held in San Diego. Dates are coordinated each year in order to fit into the schedules of all the Commanderies which participate.

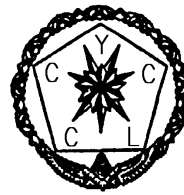
