The following is offered for Knights Templar history buffs, sent by our Grand Recorder, S.K. Ken Hope:

The earliest recorded minute in the world of the Knights Templar degree being worked is from the minutes of the first meeting of an Irish Royal Arch Lodge meeting under the authority of the charter of St. Andrew's Lodge No. 82 (Scottish Constitution) on the 20th August 1769.

The Royal Arch Lodge was formed by Brethren from the 14th, 29th (Glittering Star No. 322) and 64th Regiments in Boston and the minutes of the first meeting record the fact that William Davis, a P.M. and member of Lodge No. 58 in the 14th Regiment, was accepted and 'made by receiving the four steps, that of Excellent, Super Excellent, Royal Arch and Knight Templars'. Members of an Irish Military Lodge, with a travelling Warrant, namely, Glittering Star Lodge No. 322, which is still active, conferred the Knight Templar degree.

Early records place Templary in Boston in 1769 at St. Andrew's Chapter of Royal Arch Masons. The most likely channel through which the Orders were propagated into the American Colonies was the British Army. The spread of Freemasonry in the colonies can largely be attributed to military lodges of the period. American Union Lodge No. 1, now in Marietta, Ohio was one such lodge.

Tracing the early history of the orders in the United States is difficult since there was no authority to charter organizations. Only a small number of Freemasons possessing the Order was sufficient to open a conclave, commandery, or encampment. Often authority was assumed from a lodge charter in an identical fashion as the formation of early chapters.

The Order of Malta most likely originated in England as was exported to America. English records place the degree in the encampment (or commandery) as early as 1780, seventeen years before Thomas Smith Webb (1771-1819) include the degree in his monitor. Like the other degrees in his monitor, Webb most likely edited the ritual for American audiences.
